

Mission Philippines May 18-27, 2015

Day 1

Dick Evans

After a teaching on Jesus wanting all to be healed and how He is in every believer, Pastor Tony called for words of knowledge from the team.

I had a word for a right shoulder. Two came forward and received their healing after a quick prayer. A third woman came up with shoulder and right hip pain. Prayed twice and all pain left. Thank you Jesus.

In the afternoon pastor taught on words of knowledge. He called for words from the people. Many came up for prayer.

I prayed with a woman who had had a stroke leaving her with a right eye issue and a left arm in pain and a clenched left hand. I asked one of the young men to come up to interpret for me as I could not understand the woman speaking in her native dialect. I had him lay his hands on her and pray. A number of prayers later her hand was unclenched and her eye was better. She began to cry and one the female team members came over to assist. She still had pain in her left arm so we prayed again and all pain left. She left without pain and with the knowledge that she was healed and Holy Spirit was bringing complete healing to her hand. Praise God.

Morning

An older woman with cataracts came forward for prayer. She said she could see very little. After taking authority over the cataracts in Jesus' name, her eyes moved around the room. She could see! She began to cry with joy and danced around.

Another woman, a stroke victim, could not speak. When the mute spirit was cast out, she said, "Thank you, Jesus." Her eyes brightened considerably and we knew she was free. We invited her to come back the next session so she could learn more about deliverance. She then gave testimony about God's goodness.

A woman with a breathing problem came for help. Two of us took authority over the problem and she took a deep breath as she rejoiced. She left with a big grin on her face.

A man stepped forward with cataracts. When the three of us commanded the cataracts to leave in Jesus' name, tears came to his eyes as he realized he could see. He began jumping up and down! Love, love, love!

Afternoon

A young woman with heart palpitations and polyps in her reproductive system received healing in the form of deliverance from a spirit of infirmity. She felt a lifting off of a huge weight. She was instructed to continue taking authority over the situation if it should return and to continue thanking Jesus.

An older woman stepped forward saying she was bothered with stomach cramps whenever she walked. When we laid hands on her, she noticed a difference. We instructed her to take steps forward. As she walked, the cramps disappeared. Praise to God!

Evening

A young lady was healed of anxiety through deliverance. Hands were laid on her for blessings and she received words of encouragement for her ministry.

A woman, who had earlier received healing for stroke damage, came back tonight. She was in distress about her family and was told to put them in the palm of her hand and throw them up to God in a symbolic gesture of letting go of them. She said she wanted to be with Jesus now and we simply loved on her. We then cast out the tormenting demon. She looked at us with eyes full of tears and a tiny smile on her face. She said she knew God had a plan for her for the rest of her life. Hallelujah!

Day 2

We prayed with a woman with chronic intestinal pain and pain in her spine. We cast out the spirit of pain and commanded it to go. She fell over in the spirit and got up totally healed.

A man came forward deaf in his left ear. We cast out the spirit of deafness. He received partial restoration immediately. So we prayed again and all hearing came back.

Man with right shoulder and arm pain. Two quick prayers and he was totally healed. All pain gone.

Woman who had a stroke her left side. Right arm was paralyzed and she could not walk. One of the team had her sit down and God grew out her legs. Then we commanded total restoration from all effects from the stroke. Then for restoration of damaged brain cells. Commanded all muscles, ligaments, tendons and nerves to be restored. Cast out the spirit of infirmity and a crippling spirit. She was now able to move her right arm. Her fingers on that hand were still unable to move. Had her stand and walk with difficulty. She was determined to walk to the front to give testimony. In her testimony we found out that she had not been able to stand or walk for ten years! She also said that she had been unable to speak well and that she could now speak without any problem. Praise Jesus!

In the afternoon impartation service we each imparted to most of the church. Holy Spirit gave me a word for all I touched. In addition I prayed with a number of people. One woman for cancerous growth on her neck. Another for family to be saved. A couple, for their marriage. Then we had praise and worship with the youth with lots of dancing and praising God. Ended with a multitude of group pictures with youth and adults. It was so refreshing to see the excitement of all the youth. They are on fire for Jesus.

Second Day: Morning

The day started with exuberant praise breaking into dancing. We drank from the Spirit and joy permeated the whole place!

During prayer ministry a young pregnant lady approached me to get a blessing for her unborn baby. I laid my hands on her abdomen and prayed health and long life blessings on the baby. She thanked Jesus for His protection of her baby.

An older lady stepped forward who had pain in her kidneys. After prayer, she was pain free and believed she had a new kidney. Then she complained of pain in her right shoulder. Deliverance prayer against the spirit of infirmity ensued and she was then

filled by Holy Spirit health. She later gave testimony of her healing and gave praise to Jesus.

An older woman, who had had a stroke ten years ago, received healing to the extent that she could walk from the place of ministry to the platform in order to give a testimony. She hadn't walked or talked since her stroke in 10 years. Praise God!

Afternoon

Lots of hugs showed that trust was increasing. Many people came back for prayer after yesterday's introduction to healing prayer. They believed God would do even more healing and brought a lot of friends.

We prayed for a lady who had been freed by the Lord of the tormenting demon. The transformation was evident as she gave testimony of her healing.

A lady asked for prayer against cancer. She cried because she truly believed she was healed. Her husband came over later and asked for prayer for their marriage to be blessed. We did so and they left praising God!

A lady with cysts on her breast asked for healing prayer. She said she felt something so we knew she was touched. Praise God! We reminded her of the teaching she received on keeping her healing and about the healing process.

Evening

A young man asked for prayer for his family to come to church. We asked the Lord to send the Breakthrough Angel to tear down the wall preventing them from coming. I also reminded him of his authority over the enemy. We discussed the way of love for him to be a witness to his family as he gives them to God.

A family asked for prayer for their family and marriage. We prayed blessings on them, especially the financial area.

A time of impartation came in which the whole team imparted blessings, words of encouragement, and prophetic words to each person who lined up to receive. About 150 people participated. It was a great time of spreading God's love and of bonding with the people.

The day ended with much joy and celebration. Warm farewells and prayers were given to the mission team as each one passed by our line to give us hugs and handshakes. The children blessed us by putting their foreheads to our hands, a practice in their culture.

Day 3

After breakfast we were taken back to the church to gather some of those that received an impartation last evening. Then we went to one of the villages to walk around and minister to the people in and out of their houses.

The homes were made of cement blocks or wood with tin roofs. All very small. There was a stream of water in which some children were playing and mothers were washing clothes. A poor place by our standards but filled with joy.

I was teamed up with two young girls and a young man. They led me to the home of a woman they knew whose husband had pain in his right wrist. She brought her husband in to their home and my team laid hands on his wrist. Guided by me they prayed in Jesus name and commanded healing, for the pain to go. After three prayers his pain was almost gone. I stepped in and prayed once again and the rest of the pain left. Praise Jesus! We then blessed both of them.

Next we went to a house with a woman with pain in her stomach area. My team prayed and all pain left. We thanked the Lord and moved on.

We went to another house and asked the people if we could bless them after they refused prayer. They said yes and we proceeded to pray a blessing and for Jesus to come and heal them.

We stopped at the next house and a young woman said her mother and father were in the back building their house and did not want us to come and pray. So we spoke a blessing over the girl, her parents, and their home.

It was humbling to see how they lived without any of the things we take for granted. They did have electricity and televisions, but not much else. And yet they all seemed content especially the children enjoying playing basketball and hanging out together in the village square, if that is what it is called.

Next we were taken to a small church where we had fresh coconut milk and coconut. I say fresh because they had just been taken off the tree and cut open for us with machetes. Very tasty and very different.

We had a brief prayer session in the little church and spoke over them what the Lord put on our hearts. We blessed them and then returned to our hotel to rest and pack. We will be leaving for the next venue in a few hours.

Morning at Abayon Village

We met up with nine evangelistic teams of young people at the church then headed for the village. Each missionary went with a team to visit an assigned part of the village.

Our team went to visit a young lady named Christine. We prayed for her to have salvation. Praises to our King! Just as we were leaving she asked for me to bless her unborn child. So I asked permission to lay hands on her extended abdomen and blessed her child.

Our next visit involved praying for healing of hypertension in a mother and a healing for her son. She immediately felt a release and was very grateful to Jesus. We blessed her son and moved on to the next home.

Afternoon Visit

We walked down the road and crossed the street to a beautiful home where we found very loving people, three of whom needed a healing touch from Jesus. We asked if they believed in Jesus --- if they had made a decision to make Him their Savior. (Apparently there had been some question from believing relatives as to their salvation.) We prayed for the three young ladies to be healed and instructed them in the authority they now have to pray for each other. The grandmother was also healed. She was so happy that she gave three of us plants from her garden. Even though we couldn't take them back home, we did accept them in love and left them with the host families. It was a wonderful final day at this venue. We returned to the hotel to pack for our trip to venue 2 and to write reports.

Day 4

After a breakfast at the hotel, we were driven to a four square church where Melody was able to bless them with three songs. Then Pastor Tony gave a short message.

A number of us had words of knowledge and many came forward for healing. I prayed for a man who had blurred vision in his right eye. Also issues with his liver. He told me he was sixty and old. I told him that I was healthy at my age and that he can be healthy too. Then I asked how old he thought I was. He said ninety? Hahaha. I laid hands on him and commanded his right eye to be healed for a new liver and for all internal organs to be renewed. He also had sinus issues and Holy Spirit healed all of his issues. Praise God.

The mission church was built at the end of an alley with open bamboo walls. Pastor Tony performed the service. The service was nice and some of us were included in the ceremony. Many pictures were taken afterwards.

A reception was held at a local Chinese fast food restaurant called Chowking. The meal was very good and very filling. I have been experiencing a wide range of new foods and tastes on this trip. And rice with every meal. The pastors from both of the morning churches were at the training sessions Thursday and Friday.

After lunch and a brief stop at our hotel to freshen up we drove to the Jesus is Lord Church. This was the beginning of the last conference for Philippine this trip. When we arrived there was a receiving line going into the church with everyone shaking our hands and welcoming us. This was a larger church than the others. It too had many excited youth. Praise and worship lasted for over two hours.

Then Melody sang three songs before Pastor Tony began to teach on our authority as believers. How He wants all healed and how to pray simple prayers using that authority. Pastor Tony called for words of knowledge.

I had a few but only lower back pain was not already called out. A number of people came forward and it was instant healing in all with lower back pain. A man came up with pain in the back of his neck. One quick prayer and all pain left. Thank you, Jesus.

I prayed with another team member for a woman with a goiter. We commanded it and all pain to go. For the goiter to dissolve and go. Pain left.

A man came forward with lower abdominal pain. He did not have any at the moment so we released the healing power of Jesus into him and commanded pain to go. I then explained that Jesus had healed him and he would no longer have that pain return. Praise God.

After a chicken and rice snack we went back into an hour or more of praise and worship. Then Pastor Tony spoke telling people what to do if the pain or sickness tries to come back. Also about the measure of faith you have been given; the same for all.

Faith is spelled r-i-s-k. As you go and take a risk He will come upon you to do what has to be done.

Prayed along with one of the pastors and a team member for a man who had asthma since birth, and pain in back of his neck. His breathing was quickly healed when the pastor prayed a quick prayer. Back pain was still present. We had him pray for himself and when I had him check the back pain was gone. Thank you, Jesus.

The word of encouragement was well received and I reminded her to continue to take authority over the enemy.

The team then rode by "bus" to the celebration at God's Kingdom Mission Christian Church. It is located at the end of an alley between two buildings. There were no walls, only bamboo adorned with rich brown stain and carved decorations. The area was brightened by drapes of red, green, white, blue, and yellow.

Elmerson and Daisy celebrated their 25th wedding anniversary by repeating their vows. Some of the team took part in the proceedings. Tony officiated while Melody and Richard were called to sponsor; Casey helped with the veiling and unveiling of the couple. Photos were taken for a while and the whole team stood up to get photographed with the couple.

From the service, we went to a reception at a restaurant, called Chow King. It was great to be in an air-conditioned room. The meal was absolutely delicious! So many Filipino foods were presented that it was quite enjoyable just to taste everything before diving in. We were thoroughly stuffed by the time we had to leave.

Our next venue began around 2:30 at Jesus Is Lord Church. There was an extended, but moving, time of praise and worship. What amazed me most was the young age of the people in the church. It was exciting to see the passion they had for the Lord. God appears to be starting a revival among that generation. Praise God!

Tony began his message around 4:00. It was well received by the people and all the pastors who were there. Some from venue 1 were present and some new ones as well. We began ministry around 8:00.

A woman came to three of us and asked if we could pray for the pain in her back and for God to remove a goiter. The pain disappeared then we commanded the goiter to be gone. After three times of prayer, we reminded her of her authority and also about the difference between miracles and healings. We encouraged her to thank Jesus continually and wait for the manifestation of the healing. She left with a big grin on her face and with a pain-free body.

Day 5

Pastor and Casey demonstrated taking someone through deliverance using the four steps. This was followed by an impartation service where we each laid hands on everyone.

I lost track of how many I prayed for. Many went down in the spirit as Holy Spirit touched them. He gave me prophetic words for some and just had me bless others. Near the end a young family came with a three year old with asthma. Three of us laid hands on him and stood in agreement that the spirit of asthma was gone.
